1. CRUSADE TRUCK (USD146,955)

A **Crusade Truck** (or gospel stage truck) is a mobile event vehicle.

It features hydraulic walls that unfold into an outdoor stage.

These trucks include built-in sound systems, LED screens, and generators.

They let missionaries quickly set up events anywhere without needing a permanent building.

These are quiet ones, protect sensitive audio equipment, such as microphones, amplifiers, and lighting.

2. NORMAL VAN TRUCK (USD50,000)

18 ton GW 28ft Curtainsider 1500 kgs rear lifter for goods – 3 seats. Air suspension Full Air Kit Air Conditioning

to be used for carrying other crusade items such chairs, tents, tarpaulin for laying at front of main stage, extra equipment such as generators, speakers, venue solar lights, etc



3. MOBILE TOILETS (USD800 each)

- Mobile toilets, (or "porta-potties"), are standalone, movable restrooms that do not need plumbing. They use chemical tanks to hold waste. They are perfect for outdoor events, weddings, crusades.

Types Available

- **Basic Units:** Standard plastic booths with a toilet, urinal, and hand sanitizer.
- **VIP/Executive Trailers:** Upscale mobile trailers with flushing toilets, running water, mirrors, and air conditioning.

Renting vs. Buying

- **Renting:** Best for short-term events (weddings, parties). Rental services deliver, set up, and clean the units.
- **Buying:** Best for long-term remote projects. E.g. multiple crusades in different locations

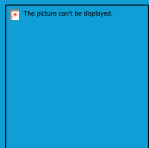
4. COASTER (USD31,000)

Start with small steps and continue to grow with the Ministry at a moderate pace with conviction to serve the Lord Jesus Christ.

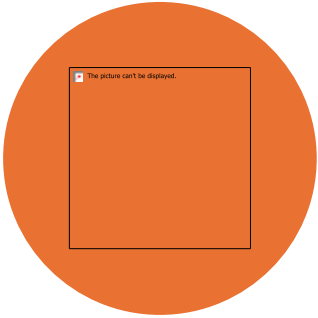

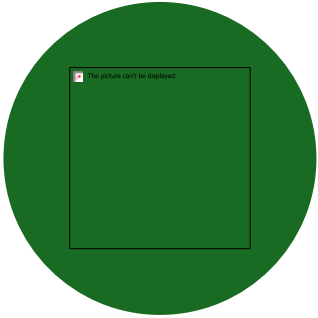


Communicate and Celebrate: Keep the Ministry updated on the good work you are doing together. Share stories and photos so the Ministry can see the real-world impact of the work of God

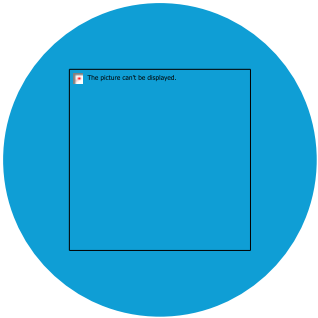
Types Partnerships



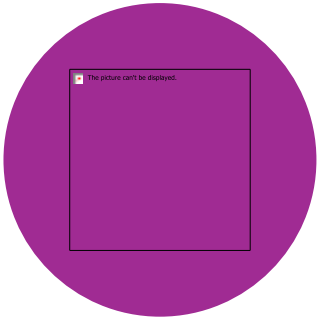
Ministry to Non-Profit: Non-profit groups or organizations work with the Ministry to find volunteers, secure space, or host donation drives.
